WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

CHAMPIONSHIP RACE HEADS TO SONOMA: Will Power took back the lead in the Verizon IndyCar Series standings from teammate Helio Castroneves at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course on Aug. 3 and following his win at Milwaukee, now carries a 39-point advantage over the Brazilian into the GoPro Grand Prix of Sonoma. Can Power score his fourth win at Sonoma and pad his points lead for the season finale at Auto Club Speedway?



TOASTING TEAM PENSKE'S SUCCESS: Team Penske looks to add to its dominance at Sonoma Raceway. The team has won five of the last six races at the track and won the pole position five times. Will Penske's title-contending trio of Will Power, Helio Castroneves and Juan Pablo Montoya provide team owner Roger Penske more hardware this weekend?

CAN BRISCOE BREAK THROUGH?: Ryan Briscoe hopes his past success at Sonoma can lead him back to Wine Country Winner's Circle.
