WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

TITLE QUEST HEADS WEST: The IZOD IndyCar Series championship is anyone's to win with 15 drivers still with a mathematical chance to grab the series title. Will Power (right) took back the championship lead from Ryan Hunter-Reay at Mid-Ohio, but Helio Castroneves and Scott Dixon are closing fast on the Aussie's point lead. Can Power win his third race in a row in Wine Country and pull away from the pack or will the title race tighten up?



NEW LAYOUT FOR 2012: The raceway at Sonoma unveiled a newly-modified track layout, which features changes to Turns 7, 9 and 11 designed to enhance passing. The raceway consulted with series officials, drivers and team representatives on the changes. With the modifications, the track will be 12 turns and 2.31 miles and race distance will increase from 75 to 85 laps.

PENSKЕ IN WINE COUNTRY: Team Penske looks to add to its dominance at Sonoma. The team has won three of the last four races at the track, including Will Power's wins from pole in 2010 and 2011, and won the pole position three times. Will the team's trio of drivers provide owner Roger Penske another podium sweep and more hardware this weekend?
