WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

POWER LOOKS TO SEW UP TITLE:

The IZOD IndyCar Series championship is anyone's to win with eight drivers still with a mathematical chance to win the series title. Will Power (right) took advantage of the misfortune of his championship rivals at Sonoma and has a 36-point advantage over Ryan Hunter-Reay. Can Power, who used his 2011 win in Baltimore to propel himself back into the title race. Can he win his second race in a row in Baltimore and keep someone from doing the same?



CAN HUNTER-REAY GET BACK IN CONTENTION? Andretti Autosport driver Ryan Hunter-Reay has proven his dominance on street circuits/road courses and ovals this season — can his dominance continue? Finishing first at the Milwaukee Mile, Iowa Corn Indy 250 and the Streets of Toronto all in a row has secured Hunter-Reay a top-three position in the championship points standing. The American driver will be looking for his fourth win of the 2012 IZOD IndyCar Series season. Quote from Hunter-Reay: “Our bad days need to be fifth or sixth place, and our good days need to be wins.”
