WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

POINTS BATTLE HEADS TO SOCAL: Even though the Verizon IndyCar Series championship still has five eligible drivers, it is essentially a three-man race between Will Power, Helio Castroneves, and Simon Pagenaud. Power took control of the lead at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course on Aug. 3 and carries a 51-point advantage into the MAVTV 500. The series championship will be decided in the final race for the ninth year in a row. Who will win the title?



LAST CHANCE TO CLAIM A WIN IN 2014: Drivers such as Marco Andretti, James Hinchcliffe, Tony Kanaan, Carlos Muñoz and Graham Rahal have finished on the podium in 2014, but they are still looking for a trip to Victory Lane. Can one of these drivers take the win at the final race of the season at Auto Club Speedway and become the record-tying 11th driver to win a race?

EYES ON ED: Ed Carpenter claimed his first win as an owner/driver at Auto Club Speedway in 2012 and would like nothing more than to win his team's final race before it joins forces with Sarah Fisher Hartman Racing in 2015. Carpenter, who won the pole for the Indianapolis 500, won at Texas Motor Speedway in June and has finished first or second in two of the last three Verizon IndyCar Series season finales. Will he keep his streak going?
